## 1. Market Overview

### The Philippine CRM market is \$134.7M growing at 13.19% CAGR

Projected to reach \$220M by 2029. Almost none of this growth targets small Filipino service businesses at the ±800–±1,200/month price point.

### 47–70% of CRM deployments in PH fail

Primary cause: poor tool fit. Tools designed for Western enterprise sales teams require complex setup that service solopreneurs have no time for.

### Zero direct competitors in the Filipino service solopreneur niche

HoneyBook is US/Canada only. Studio Ninja charges USD only. Dubsado was built for US freelancers. No Filipino-built CRM exists at peso pricing.

## 2. The Real Competition (Not Zoho — This)

### Facebook Messenger + manual replies (Critical threat)

The #1 cause of lost leads: response latency. An inquiry arrives, nobody replies fast enough, and the lead moves to a faster competitor.

### Google Sheets + Excel (High threat)

Free, familiar, good enough for 2–5 bookings/month. Breaks down at 10+ active leads. This transition moment is the primary acquisition opportunity.

### Eventchy (Partner, not competitor)

"Eventchy gets you found. Crafty CRM gets you booked and paid." Leads still arrive via Messenger after a client finds you on Eventchy.

### 3. When Filipino Solopreneurs Switch Tools

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#### **A lost booking**

They forgot to follow up, missed a date, or double-booked. Acute, memorable pain — the highest-intent moment for CRM adoption.

#### **Crossing the 10-booking threshold**

Handling 8–10 simultaneous inquiries. GSheets no longer scales emotionally. Cognitive load becomes unbearable.

#### **A peer testimonial**

"May gamit na akong tool, mas okay na." Social proof from a trusted peer in the same industry triggers the switch.

### 4. Positioning That Converts

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#### **vs. Messenger + Sheets**

"Your Messenger is full of leads you forgot to follow up on. Crafty CRM remembers so you don't have to."

#### **vs. Studio Ninja / Dubsado**

"Studio Ninja is \$27/month in dollars. Crafty CRM is ±800 in pesos. And it actually sends SMS."

#### **vs. Zoho / HubSpot**

"Zoho gives you 50 blank fields. Crafty CRM comes pre-built for photobooth businesses."
